1. This module is divided into five sections. There will be course videos, handouts, and discussion board posts associated with each session, if applicable. You can take this course in English or in Spanish.

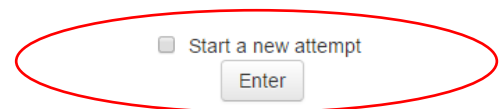

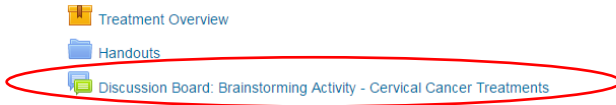
