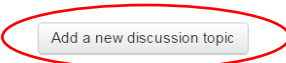



- 4.) How do you feel now? What do you do to improve your health?



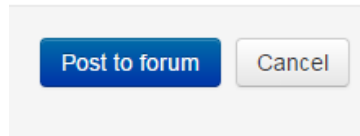
