Advancing the Access to Cancer Training, Information, Outreach and Navigation (ACTION) project for CHW dissemination of resources to at-risk Texas regions

This memorandum of understanding signifies the commitment of the parties identified below to collaborate on an initiative through a Dissemination of CPRIT-Funded Cancer Control Interventions grant (PP190035) to disseminate best practices for implementation through training and product dissemination. Specifically, this network of dissemination partners will focus on assisting with the promotion and coordination of trainings, distributing project products (i.e. implementation guide), and identifying technical assistance and training topics with a particular focus on working with vulnerable populations. Through these efforts, connections will be made to a wide variety of organizations to promote best practices for utilizing Community Health Workers to disseminate cancer prevention strategies and tools.

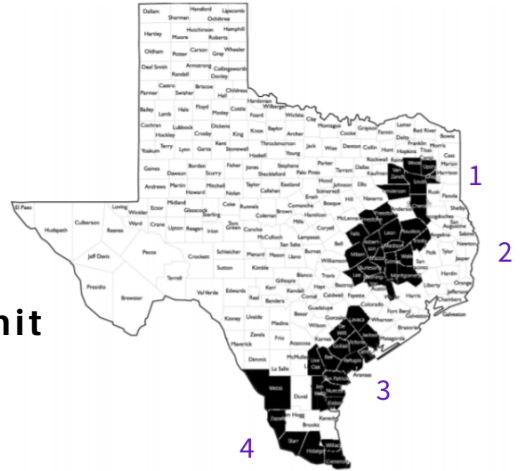
Official Dissemination Partners must actively be serving at least one of the 4 priority regions. MOUs are required to be signed by Official Dissemination Partners.
